



TEMPORARY DRIVEWAY - CHAIN GATE

SCALE : NONE

TEMPORARY GATE NOTES:

ALL POSTS, HINGES, CLAMPS, CAPS, ETC. SHALL BE GALVANIZED. EYE BOLTS SHALL INCLUDE LOCKING WASHERS AND NUTS.

RED AND WHILE STRIPED SAFETY CHAIN MUST BE PERMANENTLY FIXED TO ONE POST. THE OTHER SIDE WILL BE CONNECTED USING A LOCK FURNISHED BY THE

ALL COSTS MUST BE INCLUDED INTO THE LUMP SUM UNIT PRICE FOR "SAFETY AND SECURITY". NO SEPARATE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE FOR THE TEMPORARY GATE.

BARRICADES SHALL BE MANUFACTURED BARRICADES MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF CURRENT FAA AC 150/5370-2 AND CONFORM TO THE FOLLOWING:

TWO (2) SOLAR POWERED LIGHTS CAPABLE OF "FLASHING" AND "STEADY BURN" OPERATIONS SHALL BE ATTACHED TO EACH BARRICADE. LIGHTS SHALL HAVE RED LENSES.

BARRICADES SHALL BE 10° x 10° x 96° WITH ORANGE AND WHITE BI-DIRECTIONAL REFLECTIVE MARKINGS ON EACH SIDE.


. BARRICADES SHALL BE MADE OF A RESILIENTLY DEFORMABLE AND NON-CONDUCTIVE MATERIAL.

BARRICADES SHALL BE CAPABLE OF MODULAR ASSEMBLY/DISASSEMBLY AND NEST FOR COMPACT STORAGE.

BARRICADES SHALL BE CAPABLE OF INTERLOCKING TO PROVIDE A CONTINUOUS ENCLOSURE.

5. BARRICADES SHALL BE FILLED WITH WATER OR SAND TO PREVENT MOVEMENT.

BARRICADES SHALL BE CONTINUOUS UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
